- Job Title:** Rescue Boat Driver
- Job Description:** The Rescue Boat Driver is responsible for driving on of the RHIB (Rigid Hulled Inflatable Boat) Race Management fleet on the race area, assisting with competitor safety or as directed by the Race Officer.
- Experience/Skills:** Required experience and skills include:
- A recreational boating license
 - Relevant experience driving RHIBs
 - Working With Children Check (WWCC)
- Desired Quals:** Desired Qualifications and experience include:
- First Aid accreditation
 - Powerboat handling/Safety boat Operator course
 - Understanding of local Brighton Waterways
 - To understand the Sailing Instructions relevant to the event
- Equipment Required:**
- Boat keys
 - Boat start-up procedure document
 - Understand the RBYC emergency response procedures
- Basic Tasks:** Tasks for this Position include (but are not limited to):
- Attend the Race Management briefing two hours before race start.
 - Ensure the boat pack has the necessary equipment to run the boat.
 - Perform boat start up procedure, complete radio check and exit the marina.
 - Following Race Officer's direction, head to the race course and monitor the fleet of competitors.
 - Perform boat/sailor retrievals as required.
 - If directed, assist with the race management duties.
 - At the completion of racing, escort the fleet to harbor and return to the marina.
 - Return equipment to the Sailing Department.
