Race Management Team – Boat Crew

Boat Crew
The Boat Crew is responsible for assisting with on water rescue or race management activities, stationed on one of the Race Management fleet, directed by the driver or race officer.
Required experience and skills include:
 Comfortable with being on the water, and able to swim, if required Working With Children Check (WWCC)
Desired Qualifications and experience include:
 First Aid accreditation Recreational boat License Understand the RBYC emergency response procedures
Boat packRadio (built in or handheld)
Tasks for this Position include (but are not limited to):
 Attend the Race Management briefing two hours before race start.
• Ensure the boat pack has the necessary equipment to run the boat.
• Following the Driver/Race Officer's direction, head to the race course and monitor the fleet of competitors.
• Perform boat/sailor retrievals as required. This may require a need to enter the water.
 If directed, assist with the race management duties. At the completion of racing, escort the fleet to harbor and return to the marina. Return equipment to the Sailing Department.
