Race Management Team – Mark Layer

- Job Title:** Mark Layer
- Job Description:** The Mark Layer is responsible for deploying and retrieving race marks and assist the Race officer as directed.
- Experience/Skills:** Required experience and skills include:
- Able to lift heavy objects
 - Able to take weather observations and relay to Race Officer
 - Ability to use and understand a GPS
 - Working With Children Check (WWCC)
- Prior Knowledge:** Desired experience and knowledge include:
- Relevant experience on the water
 - Understanding of local Brighton Waterways
 - To understand the courses relevant to the event
- Equipment Required:**
- Marks, Weights and Anchors
 - GPS (either in built or Handheld)
 - Wind recording instruments (inbuilt or anemometer)
 - Current Racing Rules of Sailing
- Basic Tasks:** Tasks for this Position include (but are not limited to):
- Attend the Race Management briefing two hours before race start.
 - Ensure the start boat pack has the necessary equipment.
 - Inflate the required marks based on the sailing instructions.
 - Load boat with the necessary marks, weights and anchors.
 - Perform boat start up procedure, complete radio checks and exit the marina.
 - Following Race Officer's direction, set up the race course in appropriate position by deploying marks based on the provided course direction/ GPs position.
 - At the completion of racing, retrieve all marks and return to the marina.
 - Pack away equipment and return boat pack to sailing department.
