

RS100 2023 National Championships Notice of Race

27 – 29 January 2023, Royal Brighton Yacht Club, Victoria

The Organising authority is the Royal Brighton Yacht Club in conjunction with the RS Sailing Association Australia.

1. Rules:

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing. The Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Australian Sailing (AS) – Part 2 will apply. Appendix T (Arbitration) will apply.

2. Advertising:

Boats may be required to display advertising as supplied by the Organising Authority.

3. Eligibility:

The regatta is open to all RS100 Skiffs whose skipper is a current financial member of a club affiliated with Australian Sailing and a member of the RS100 Class Association.

4. Entries:

Entry is available online at https://sailingresults.net/entry/default.aspx?ID=E9264281 Entry Fee is \$220 up until January 20th 2023 and \$270 after this date up until 5pm January 27th.

5. Schedule:

Racing will normally be back to back with a total of 9 races scheduled and a maximum of 4 races in any one day.

6. Sailing Instructions

- a) The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be posted on the official notice board located at https://sailingresults.net/sa/notice/?ID=81440
- b) No hard copies will be available at the regatta.

7. Courses

The courses to be sailed will be windward-leeward courses as described in the Supplementary Sailing Instructions.

8. Penalties

RRS rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

9. Scoring

- A maximum of 9 races to be sailed of which 4 races shall constitute a series.
- When 5 or fewer races completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- When from 6 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

10. Prizes

Prizes will also be awarded as follows:

- 1st, 2nd, 3rd on Scratch Overall
- Masters division: ages 45 to 54 yr
- Grand masters: ages 55 to 64 yr
- Great grand masters: ages 65 and over

Ages as at 27 January 2023.

Further prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organising authority.

11. Disclaimer of Liability

- a) Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- b) It is the competitor's decision to enter an Event or to start and continue in any race. Competitors shall accept that their participation in an Event is at their exclusive risk in every respect. See Racing Rule 3, Decision to Race.
- c) None of the Organising Authority, RS Sailing Association Australia, Australian Sailing, their officers, members, volunteers, servants or agents accept any responsibility whatsoever in respect of loss of life, personal injury or damage to property which may be sustained by reason of their participation or intended participation in this event or howsoever arising in connection with the event.

12. Insurance

All competing boats shall have third party insurance cover of not less than AUS\$10,000,000 or equivalent thereof in any other currency. A copy of current insurance policies may be requested at registration.

13. Rights to use Name and Likeness

In participating, a competitor automatically grants to the Organising Authority and the sponsors, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the said Event without compensation.
