**NOTE**

**All Flag Officers and four (4) of the six (6) Committee Members must be Active Sailing Members** *(All Senior Members being owners of sailing yachts on the Yacht Register and all Senior Members who have been regular members of the crew of any sailing yacht for at least five seasons during their membership or for at least three racing seasons during the five years immediately preceding the current Club financial year shall be deemed Active Sailing Members of the Club.)*

All nominations of Candidates for Election to the Flag Officers and the Committee shall be in writing and signed by the Nominator, Secunder and Candidate, all of whom shall be Senior Members and have paid all their annual subscription, fees and levies for the current year due by them to the Club.

No Member shall be eligible for Election to the Flag Officers or the Committee unless he/she has been a Senior Member for at least three (3) consecutive years immediately preceding their nomination.

Nomination forms for the Election of Flag Officers and the Committee may be obtained by requesting a form via email [reception@rbyc.org.au](mailto:reception@rbyc.org.au) or from the office from Monday 17<sup>th</sup> July 2023. Director ID number is also required.

A Ballot for Election of the Flag Officers and the Committee will be held on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> September 2023. This will be held Electronically with Postal Ballot also available. Full details to be advised. An application to the Secretary for a Postal Ballot, must be in writing, signed by the Member eligible to vote. (An application form for a Postal Ballot is attached for voting members.) Applications may be made using this form or other form of written request signed by the Member and provided to the Secretary by post or other means. Ballot papers will be sent to Member applicants by post or other means after nominations close on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> August 2023 at 12 noon. Completed Postal Ballots must be post marked not later than twelve noon on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> September 2023 and received by close of business on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> September.

Members' attention is drawn to Part 4, Division 3 Election of Committee Members and tenure of office in the Rules. Also Rule 34 (1) (b) financial, meaning that all Member subscriptions and boat storage due and payable by that Member to the Club have been paid.
