RBYC Voting - 2024 Amended 05.09.2024

The voting procedure has been amended following an independent review of our Voting procedure and RBYC Rules.

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As there were seven (7) valid nominations for the six (6) members of Committee a ballot will be held.

The Club Rules allow for in-person or postal or electronic voting (under certain circumstances). After review and in line with the club rules, the election will go ahead using only the in person and postal methods of voting.

In-Person Voting – Members will be able to vote by visiting the club between 10am and 4pm on Saturday 14th September, completing and depositing a ballot form. Voting will close at 4pm on Saturday 14th September 2024.

Postal Voting - Postal ballots must reach the Secretary not later than midday on Saturday 14th September 2024, such ballot paper to be in the form prescribed by the Committee and obtainable from the Secretary by email application gm@rbyc.org.au or in person.

Electronic Voting – will <u>not</u> be used.

Members are reminded that **only financial members are entitled to vote**. Meaning that all Member subscriptions and boat storage due and payable by that Member to the Club have been paid.

Members of the following classes of Membership have a voting right for both the election of the Committee and for the passing of ordinary and special resolutions at a General Meeting:

Senior Special Members
40 Year Members
50 Year Members
Honorary Life Members
Country Members
Absentee Members
Crew & Crew Plus Members
Intermediate Members

Other membership categories **do not** have voting rights for Committee elections and therefore will not be able to vote.

Please note the following;
