## Treasurers Report for August 2025

Welcome all to the new financial year. This year is budgeted to bring a much smaller operating surplus, mostly due to the increase in insurance costs (covered in May 2025 treasurers report) and employment expenses increasing due to the both a minimum award increase of 3.5% & superannuation guarantee of 0.5%. The month of July looks remarkably like July 2024, with improved catering revenue, cost of sales and lower employment expenses. The operating surplus of \$36k was ahead of the budgeted \$11k with expenses \$33k lower then expected.

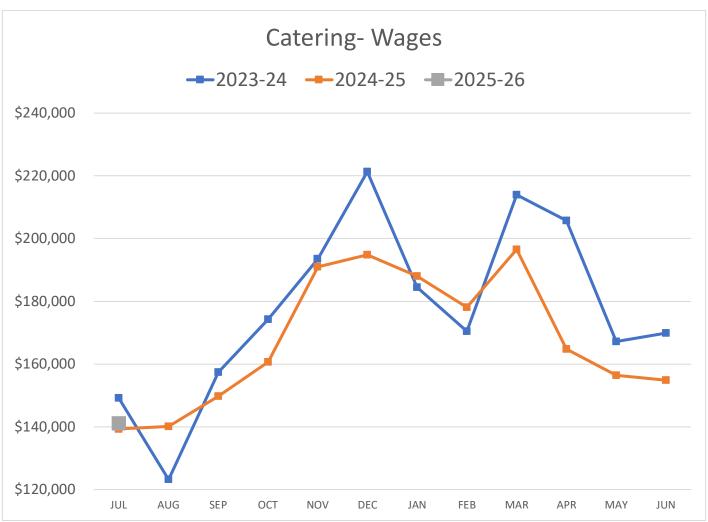

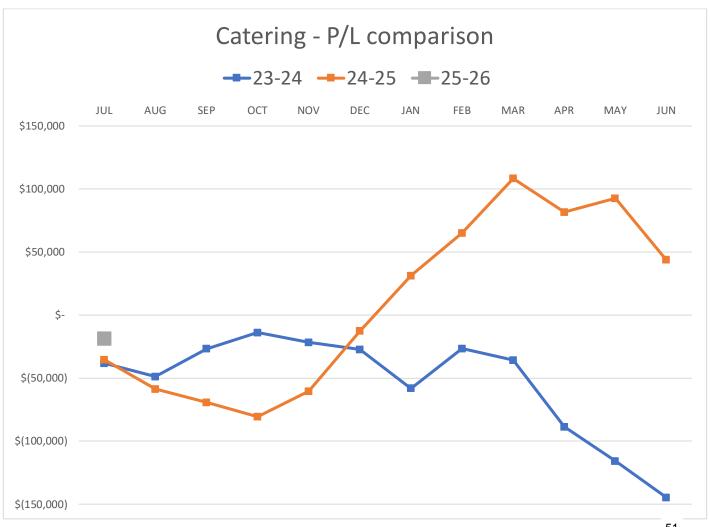

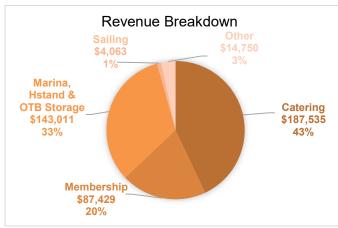
## Royal Brighton Yacht Club Financial Results – July 2025

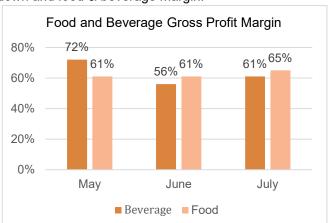
Below is a summary of the club's financial performance for July 2025, including key commentary and comparisons of the same period last year.

## Financial Results - July 2025

The club delivered a strong financial performance in July, with total income reaching \$436k. Gross profit came in at \$371k.

Please refer to the below chart for the total revenue breakdown and food & beverage margin.





Compared to the same period last year, total revenue saw a modest decline of \$2k. However, a \$7k reduction in cost of sales led to a \$5.8k increase in gross profit. These improved cost controls also contributed to a stronger year-on-year operating profit.
